"HAPPY VALLEY" ROUTE

TO

BASIS *Peoria* & BASIS *Peoria Primary*

- **ROUTE DESCRIPTION:** The "HAPPY VALLEY" Route to BASIS Peoria and BASIS Peoria Primary accommodates students living along the corridor of W. Happy Valley Rd., from 19th Avenue & W. Jomax Rd. to Lake Pleasant Parkway.
- PICKUP/DROPOFF POINTS:
 - 1. Corner of 19th Avenue and W. Jomax.-Morning: cut out-NW corner of intersection. Afternoon: cut out-SW corner of intersection PROVIDED THERE ARE NO PARENT CARS PARKED THERE
 - **2.** Corner of 23rd Avenue and W. Happy Valley Rd.- Morning: Norterra Mall, parking lot in front of Dick's Sporting Goods and T-Mobile, NW corner of intersection. Afternoon: Parking lot between Bank of America and Carl's Junior, SW corner of intersection
 - **3. Corner of 39th Dr. and W. Happy Valley Rd.- Morning and Afternoon: Safeway Mall,** parking lot between Safeway Gas Station and Burger King, NE corner of intersection
 - **4. Corner of 55th Ave & Stetson Valley Pkwy-Morning:** cutout at the NW corner of intersection. **Afternoon:** cutout at the SW corner of intersection **PROVIDED THERE ARE NO PARENT CARS PARKED THERE**
 - **5. 59**th **Ave & W. Happy Valley Rd. Morning and Afternoon:** Glendale Community College West Parking Lot-Central Plant
 - **6. Corner of 67th Ave. & W. Happy Valley Rd. Morning**: Walmart parking lot, NE corner of intersection. **Afternoon:** Fry's Supermarket parking lot, SE corner of intersection

7. Last Stop before school: Lake Pleasant Parkway & W Happy Valley Rd. - Morning and Afternoon: Fry's Supermarket parking lot-NE corner of intersection

The route subsequently continues on Lake Pleasant Parkway to BASIS *Peoria* and BASIS *Peoria Primary* depending on which group of students starts school first. Transportation will be provided with 2 (two) a 28-35 passenger shuttles.

• DAILY TRIPS (see Tentative Schedule for timing)

- 2 morning trips to both schools, accommodating students of all grades, Monday through Friday, excluding school holidays:
 - The 1st morning trip will accommodate students with school start times at 7:20am and at 7:30am.
 - The 2nd morning trip will accommodate students with school start times at 7:45am, 8:00am and 8:15am.

• 3 afternoon trips to both schools, accommodating students of all grades, Monday through Friday, excluding school holidays:

- The 1st afternoon trip will accommodate students with school release times at 2:35pm and 2:40pm.
- The 2nd afternoon trip will accommodate students with school release times at 3:10pm, 3:30pm and 3:40pm.
- The 3rd afternoon trip will accommodate students that have to stay for extracurricular activities and student hours, and will be departing the schools at approximately 5:00pm.

NOTE: The 3rd afternoon trip will not accommodate students doing extracurricular activities outside the schools' premises, and may not accommodate all extracurricular activities (for example, if an extracurricular activity ends **AFTER** the departure time of the 3rd afternoon shift, this extracurricular activity will NOT be accommodated.

PRICING

> \$2,800.00 annual cost per student, round trip (10 monthly installments of \$280.00 per month, for the 10 months of the school year)

An 8% discount is available for siblings. Other discounts are available for early payment.

- Proration for AY 2017-2018, assuming the school year started on August 9, 2017, and that the route starts on October 8, 2017 (this is provided as an EXAMPLE ONLY), the following proration will be made:
 - \$2,800.00 annual cost divided by 180 school days = \$15.55 per school day.
 - o Number of school days between August 9, 2018 and October 7, 2017 = 42.
 - 42 school days missed x \$15.55 per school day= \$653.10
 - \$2,800.00 \$653.10 = \$2,146.90 remaining annual amount.

• ROUTE REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum number of 50 "enrolled" students is required for the Happy Valley Route to materialize for AY 2017-2018. It does not matter if the 50 students are split 25 in the early bus and 25 in the late bus. As long as the total number of students in the two buses is 50, the route will materialize for AY 2017-2018
- "Enrolled student" means a student for whom A School Ride has received a complete set of enrollment documents and a deposit
- We do not accept students for one-way transportation (i.e., morning only or afternoon only)
- We do not accept students for partial year transportation (i.e., for certain days only, or for certain months only)
- > Parents are required to sign an Annual Transportation Service Agreement
- > Parents are required to send a deposit of one month's fee at the time of enrollment
- At this time (September 2, 2017), there are **60 spaces available** in the "Happy Valley" Route.
- ➤ Incoming students are serviced on a "first come-first served" basis

DEADLINE TO ENROLL

- The deadline to enroll to the "Happy Valley" Route to BASIS Peoria & BASIS Peoria Primary is Sunday, September 17, 2017 at 5:00pm.
- Participating parents need to be aware that after September 17, 2017, and if we gather the number of students we need to start the Happy Valley Route, <u>A School Ride will need a minimum of 3-4 weeks to prepare and test the route for operation. The earliest the Route may commence is Monday, October 8, 2017.</u>

All grades can travel in the 3rd afternoon shift if they have extracurriculars or student hours that end before 5:00pm

If you have a student in Grade K and a student in Grade 2, they can both travel in the 1st morning shift and in the 2nd afternoon shift so that you don't have to go to the stop twice.

WHO WE ARE

A School Ride LLC was born in August 2009, from our need to transport our daughter to and from BASIS *Scottsdale*. Driving Kristen to and from school, 20 miles away, twice daily, was not an option for two working professionals.

While carpooling was a possibility, our primary concern was <u>liability insurance</u> in case of an accident. Knowing that most non-commercial drivers carry close to the statutory minimum insurance coverage for their vehicles, we were unwilling to risk a worst case scenario of an accident while carpooling to school with 2-3 other students.

We formed the LLC, purchased a minivan and commercial auto liability insurance, hired a commercial driver, and started this service with 7 students of similarly minded parents from the Desert Ridge/Grayhawk areas.

In our 9th year of operations, we transport over 300 students to and from charter and private schools daily.

A School Ride LLC is a licensed and insured transportation solution for students and their busy parents. Convenient pick-up and drop-off locations are close to students' homes and serve a growing student population.
